



EWF is recognising the best Welding Coordinator in Europe!

Requirements:

A person under the age of 45 who is an I/EWE, recognised as a Responsible Welding Coordinator (RWC) (in accordance with ISO 14731) at the Comprehensive Level in a company which is certified to ISO 3834

and

A person that has significantly contributed to the application of new welding/joining technology in the company and/or improved efficiency in welding production systems. There must be clear evidence of benefit, for example: reduced costs, increased productivity, improved reliability, and/or an enhanced workplace safety or environmental management from the welding point of view.

These rules are for guidance but not mandatory

How to apply:

To apply for the award you need to submit to the ANB in your country:

- ▶ a summary of the RWC activities and its impact (max. five A4 pages with Annexes, if needed)
- ▶ the CV
- ▶ a letter from the employer indicating the endorsement of the application

Deadline:

Nominations from 1 December 2011 until 15 February 2012.

The award will include:

- ▶ Free registration for EUROJOIN 2012 and 1000€ to support the travel and accommodation in Pula, Croatia to participate in the Eurojoin Conference
- ▶ The Award (Certificate and Cheque) will be handed in the Opening Ceremony of the Eurojoin Conference
- ▶ Promotion through EWF website and EWF Newsletter
